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Aging & In-Home Services Announces Expansion of Community Care Hub Indiana

Fort Wayne, Ind. – Aging & In-Home Services of Northeast Indiana, Inc. (AIHS) announced expansion of their Community Care Hub Indiana (CCHI) through a partnership with CICOA Aging & In-Home Solutions (CICOA), Indianapolis.

CCHI is a nonprofit organization formed by AIHS and designated by Administration of Community Living (ACL), U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in November 2022 as part of a national effort to support the advancement of community integrated health care.

In April, the Indiana Association of Area Agencies on Aging (i4a) Board members voted to utilize CCHI as its contracting arm for the Indiana Pathways for Aging Program. Indiana Pathways for Aging will promote the health and well-being of people who need assistance with activities of daily living due to long-term conditions or disabilities, or who require supervision and support due to cognitive impairment. These services will include in-home personal care, adult day centers, caregiver support, assisted living and nursing facility care. Indiana Pathways for Aging is scheduled to launch summer 2024.

Aging & In-Home Services of Northeast Indiana, Inc. (AIHS), a federal and state designated Area Agency on Aging (AAA) and Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC), is a non-profit community-based organization with a mission to promote dignity, independence, and advocacy for older adults, persons with disabilities and their caregivers.
