AIHS selected by CMS to participate in the National Community-based Care Transitions Program (CCTP) Demonstration

2012

GGH expands and provides services via our nationwide network of AAAs and CBOs in total of 26 states via Commercial, Medicaid and Medicare markets for an average of 30,000 MCO member referrals per month

2020

GGH expands into additional 9 states and adds Medicaid Markets in addition to Commercial

2018

CCHI transitioned to a separate nonprofit joint venture between AIHS and CICOA Aging & In-Home Solutions, based in Indianapolis.

Indiana Association of Area Agencies on Aging officially voted to utilize CCHI as its contracting arm for Indiana Pathways (mLTSS).

2023

PCHP sells GGH to tech company from Tampa, FL with AIHS continuing to provide Administrative Oversight and Care Coordination services to the full GGH nationwide network.

Initial Care Transition (CT) pilot partnership between AIHS and Parkview Health

2013

Full launch of CCTP by AIHS in 11 hospitals in NE and North Central IN covering discharge to 36 counties in Indiana and Western Ohio 2017

CMS CCTP ends with AIHS as one of the final participating organizations. CMS Final Report (Nov. 2017) indicated AIHS's CCTP (Site 54) was able to produce statistically significant lower participating readmission rates (19.95; p<0.01) and had a total cost savings to Medicare of \$5,026,626

Preferred Community Health Partners, LLC (PCHP) is formed by AIHS and PPHM as a Management Services Organization to begin contracting with Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to provide CT and Complex Care Cioordination services branded as GroundGameHealth (GGH). The first national contract implemented with major MCO to provide GGH in 5 states via the MCOs Commercial Markets.

2022

AIHS selected by the Administration for Community Living as a Community Care Hub serving the State of IN. AIHS names entity 'Community Care Hub Indiana'
